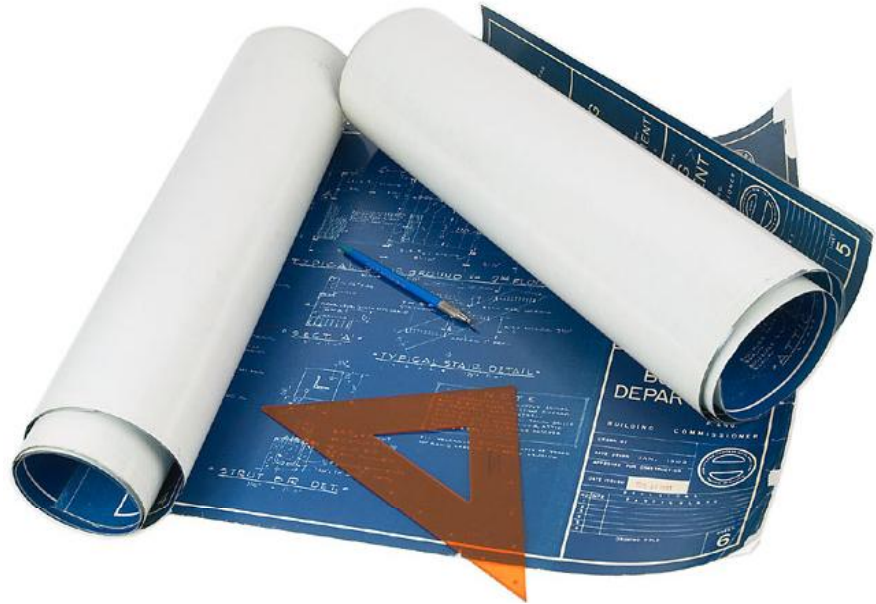

This interior renovation project consisted of the food service area and cafeteria at the Detroit Blue Cross Blue Shield Building. The project began with the demolition of the existing kitchen and coffee room and encompassed the installation of new ceilings, new flooring, new lighting and wiring in all areas. The cafeteria also received new kitchen equipment and islands designed to maximize functionality of every inch of space. The counter facias and tray rails were also replaced, and all wall coverings were stripped and repainted or recovered as designed.

This renovation project was phased to allow the facility to remain open to the facilities employees and fully functional during the construction process. A very detailed and well organized schedule as well as proper oversight from the site superintendent and project manager allowed this project to be completed with very limited disruptions to the client and their staff.
