The College's original building, known as the "Yamasaki Building", after its famed designer, Minoru Yamasaki, was originally constructed in 1957. The facility houses the college's registration, financial aid and academic affairs offices, and is heavily utilized by faculty and students on a daily basis.

JM Olson Corporation was contracted to the architectural upgrades of the Yamasaki Building. This project included the replacement of the entire glass curtain wall, as well as the roof and skylight systems. The mechanical and electrical systems received full upgrades and an elevator was installed. This project was completed while the facility remained operational and open to faculty, student, and visitors.
