The old City Hall on Munro Street, originally a one-room schoolhouse built in 1935, was torn down to make way for the new municipal complex in the city of Gibraltar. JM Olson Corporation was chosen to build the new complex that is a combination City Hall, Fire Station and Police Department and also houses employees from the Clerk's and Treasurer's offices and the Department of Public Works. It also includes a City Council chambers and a museum.

The new two-story, 34,790 SF municipal complex is built of a wood, steel and masonry frame with brick and glass exterior, shingled roof and a lighthouse design on the front. The site was re-landscaped and paved with extensive sidewalks and site lighting.

The interior has vinyl wall covering and paint, wood doors and trim, ceramic tile, vinyl tile and carpet. The Lobby floor has a tiled city logo.
