The Salvation Army Adult Rehabilitation Center (ARC) located in the heart of downtown Detroit offers programs specializing in drug and alcohol rehabilitation. The ARC offers counseling, work therapy, housing, social and spiritual assistance for men in the community. The renovated ARC includes a 300 bed residential rehabilitation center, administrative and counseling offices, dining/food services and a chapel. The facility also has recreational and meeting areas for residents and staff. This project also features a 100,000 sf sorting and distribution center which includes operations offices, a call center, truck maintenance area, and a retail store.

The chapel facility is located on the sixth floor of the multi level structure and is comprised of approximately 7,000 SF. The newly constructed facility has seating for 500 to 700 worshipers and features state of the art audio system and equipment.
