\$9,750,000, 204,479 SF retail store featuring a grocery department with refrigeration facilities for cold and frozen foods as well as fruits and vegetables, a garden center, a pharmacy, and other various textile departments. This project was completed in April 2005.

Wal-Mart Superstore

Sandusky, Michigan

\$8,525,000, 155,204 SF located on 21.80 acres. This superstore featured a grocery department with full refrigeration facilities for cold and frozen food as well as fruits and vegetables, a deli, a garden center, pharmacy, snack bar, vision center, and other textile departments. This location also offered its customers an automotive center. This store was completed and opened to the public in July 2005.
