JM Olson Corporation provided construction management services for the new Washtenaw County recreation center. The Meri Lou Murray Recreation Center is a 51,000 sf facility that is open to seniors, adults and children living in the community. The facility was built on a very challenging site; a steep hill overlooking wetlands. JM Olson hauled and relocated 35,000 cubic yards of soil in order to accommodate the new two-story building.

The recreation center houses a pool, a full-size gymnasium complete with two basketball and volleyball courts, a peripheral synthetic surface running track, exercise rooms, locker rooms/showers, arts and crafts rooms, administrative offices and an expandable dance room with hard wood flooring.

Prior to starting construction, the community decided they wanted to preserve an historic barn that was located on the perspective building site of the recreational center. JM Olson was asked to move the barn from the project site, which they did, several hundred feet and also placed it on a new foundation.
