JM Olson provided fast-tracked services for a two-story, 153,000 sf Executive-level training center addition and a 50,000 sf renovation to the existing training facility at the Ford Training and Development Center. The expansion doubles the size of the existing facility and allows Ford to centralize training programs of Ford Credit, Executive Development Center and Marketing, Sales and Services.

Constructed within a fast tracked ten-month schedule, the new addition houses 16 classrooms, 28 breakout rooms, four computer labs, two-observation room, several conference rooms, lounges, auditorium, eight television studios and a **500-seat dining room**. This new facility offers the latest technology, including a fiber-optics technology, a wider computer band network, video-conferencing capabilities and satellite links for sending and receiving information. Additionally, the building incorporates high vaulted ceiling, high-end finishes such as marble and terrazzo and its common areas are adorned with stunning chandeliers.
