JM Olson is providing general contracting services for the Michigan State University Veterinary Oncology Center Addition in East Lansing. This addition allows the center to provide Veterinary Oncology services for small domesticated and farm animals.

The construction of the facility was done within a design framework that limited square footage and costs, but nevertheless allowed for aesthetically pleasing elements. Clients are welcomed into a two story atrium. A focal point that serves as gathering space for both faculty and clients.

Phase I encompassed approximately 42,000 square feet of new space for the Oncology Center and provides ideal service relationships between Oncology Clinics, Medical Oncology, Nuclear Medicine, and Radiation Oncology. The center will house a linear accelerator, which provides radiation treatment for cancer patients, as well as modern exam rooms, holding facilities and offices. Phase II will house research laboratory functions and provide clinic expansion possibilities.

The building has also been constructed to optimize future vertical expansion capabilities, and incorporates all the necessary components to support research and development.
