As part of Detroit Metro Airport’s continuous expansion program, JM Olson provided fast-track general contracting for the new \$8.2 million, 12-gate Concourse “G” located at the J.M. Davey Terminal.

The new concourse, which is wider and shorter than before, is designed to minimize walking distances to commuter gates. In the past, passengers averaged 535 steps from the Davey Terminal to the commuter gates. Now, passengers average a mere 150 steps. Additionally, the new concourse will interact with the expanded ticket lobby and baggage recheck area in the International Terminal. Scope of work included the coordination with airport contractors and security. All electrical work was coordinated with the Federal Aviation Authority.
