The Waterford School District is proud of their new facilities that opened at Mott High School. The district committed \$27 million for additions to their two high schools for new state-of-the-art gymnasiums and auditoriums at both Mott and Kettering High Schools.

The building addition at Mott totaling 53,300 square feet accommodates a new 800 seat full-performance auditorium, a new field house, a relocation of the administration area which was reoriented for added security and organized the facility into functional zones. The gymnasium will be used for educational instruction, athletic practices and performances, intramural activity, educational presentations, and community use. With a seating capacity of 1,800 the gymnasium has two full-size basketball courts, three full-size volleyball courts, an indoor running track, and a fitness, wellness, aerobic, and resistance training activity space.

Also included at Mott High School was the auditorium which is used for academics, performing arts curriculum, physical education curriculum, career and technical education, as well as performances, presentations, and community use. The auditorium has a seating capacity for 800 and a stage that totals 4,300 square feet. Two multipurpose classrooms/dressing rooms were added for academic and performance use. State-of-the-art lighting, recessed orchestra pit that hosts up to 30 musicians is also included.
